



URGENT ALERT: Ask Your State Senator to Vote NO on HB 2244!

We have just learned that the worst bill targeting citizen initiatives may be voted on by the entire Senate as early as today, and we need your help to stop it! We apologize for so many alerts, but this is a unique legislative session where Humane Voters of AZ and other groups are simultaneously working to pass animal protection bills while fighting the Legislature's worst attack to date on our citizen initiative process.

[HB 2244](#) would require 'strict compliance' for initiatives, which could cause many perfectly valid signatures to be tossed out for even the smallest technical mistake, such as using the wrong type or margin size. This would make it extremely difficult for grassroots groups to place an initiative on the ballot.
