

Katie Hobbs' Legislative Record on Animal Protection

2011: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

2012: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

Prime Sponsor of HB2462 Animal Seizures (passed)

Allows law enforcement to enter properties to seize an animal if there is probable cause to believe that the animal is suffering from cruelty or abandonment.

2013: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

Prime Sponsor SB1240 Public Animal Sales (failed)

Would have expanded the ban on roadside animal sales statewide

2014: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

2015: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

2016: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

Prime Sponsor SB1227 (failed but a version of the bill was passed in 2019)

Sen. Kavanagh's bill would have raised penalties to a felony for 'second-strike' abusers; defined proper food, water and shelter; and raised required bond amount in animal seizure hearings.

2017: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

2018: 100% voting record on animal/initiative bills

Prime Sponsor SB1440 (failed)

Would have repealed HB2244, passed by the Legislature in 2017, that requires strict compliance for citizen initiatives.
